## **Advices and Tips**

- 1. Cow skins and carpets should be vacuumed or beaten once and awhile. When vacuuming please follow the hair to minimize unnecessary tearing.
- 2. Natural Cow skin can under normal circumstances be cleaned with a piece of cloth dipped in clean, lukewarm water.
- 3. After awhile you can have stains, which will not come off with clean water. On the natural colored Cow skins and carpets we recommend a scour product to clean and impregnate.
- 4. Dyed skin is to be carefully cleaned with a piece of cloth dipped in clean, lukewarm water.

  The scour product **should not** be used to clean dyed skins or carpets.
- 5. Dyed Cow skin **is not** to be subjugated to direct sunlight, hence the colors will fade.
- 6. It is generally a good idea to turn/rotate cow skins on the floor once and awhile, to ensure that they wear out evenly.
- 7. If parts of the skin are curling, you can moisturize those areas; and then roll the skin in the opposite direction and let it dry.
- 8. Remember that all Cow skins and carpets are unique in the coloring, and the natural colors will always fit with similar natural colors in your home environment such as: Tree, Granite, Wool, Leather etc.
